Public Compliance Statement of Guiding Principles of Fundraising

ALONE is committed to complying with the *Statement for Guiding Principles for Fundraising* and has formally discussed and adopted the Statement at a meeting of the governing body.

ALONE confirms its commitment to the principles set out in the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising* by a statement which will be included in the 2013 annual report and all future annual reports.

ALONE has a Donor Charter which is consistent with the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising*.

ALONE regularly monitors compliance with the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising* and compliance reports are received regularly by the governing body.

ALONE considers the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising* when planning all fundraising activity.

ALONE provides honest, open and transparent disclosure when fundraising from the public.

ALONE has appointed a member of staff to be responsible for compliance with the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising*.

ALONE ensures that fundraising staff are provided with information and training on the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising and its implementation.

ALONE has a feedback and complaints procedure consistent with the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising*. Feedback is recorded for review by relevant staff including the CEO and governing body. Feedback is responded to promptly and appropriately.

ALONE prepares financial reports consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 which include a statement concerning the extent to which control of the organisation is independent of its funding sources.

ALONE ensures that all donations are tracked and recorded and complies with data protection requirements.

ALONE is accessible to the public through a number of readily available contact options.
