

Instructions to access the BFriend App

If you visit an older person as part of ALONE's Visitation Support and Befriending Service and haven't registered on the BFriend App yet, please scan the QR code below or visit bfriend.alone.ie



* It is important to note that if you are a volunteer who is using both the BFriend App and the Telephone Support App, the same login details are used for both.

So, once you have completed the process of creating a password for one app, you do not need to do it again for the other.

Accessing the App for the first time on your mobile phone or computer

STEP 1

Click the link to the App [here](#) or go to the website bfriend.alone.ie and then click the "Don't remember your password" link on the logon page.

This will prompt an email to be sent to you to create a new password.

Creating password:

When creating a new password, it is recommended to use a ten-character alphanumeric password.

It must be a minimum of eight (your choice). The password must contain at least three of the four-character classes:
(a) Uppercase letters (b) Lowercase letters (c) Numbers (d) Special characters. Use this password and your email as your username to log into the App for the first time.

STEP 2

Android

1. Tap the Menu icon - the three dots (Image 1) – the dots might be at the bottom or top of your screen depending on the model of the phone
2. Add page + (Image 2)
3. Add the current webpage to the Home Screen (Image 3)
4. The App will now show on your phone Home Screen

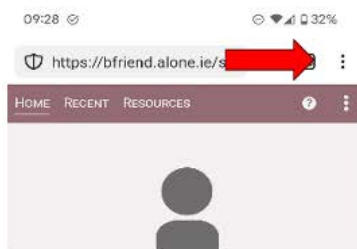

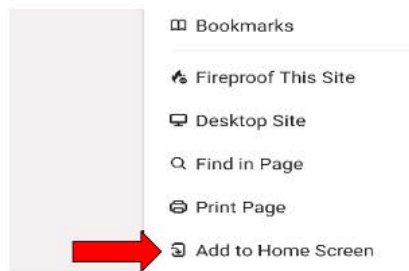

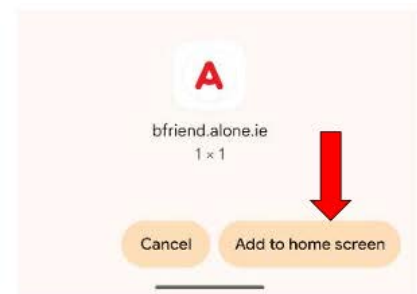

1. Tap the Share icon (Image 4)
2. Add to Home Screen (Image 5 & 6)
3. The App will now show on your phone Home Screen

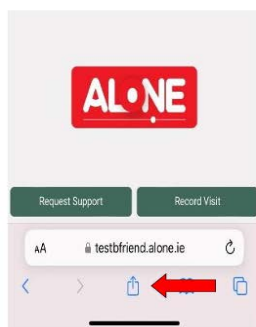

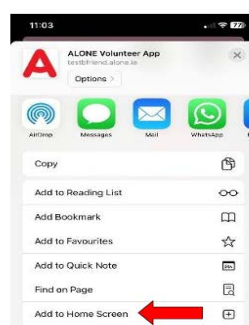

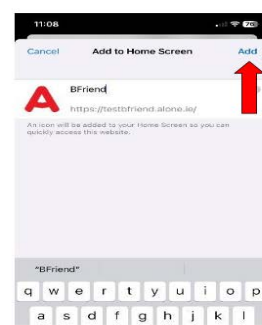

Computer

1. From the home screen of the app click the Favourites icon (star) (Image 7 & 8 red arrow)
2. The app is now accessible from the bookmarked link in the Favourites bar (Image 7 – blue arrow)

Note: The bookmark should be created from the Home page of the App.

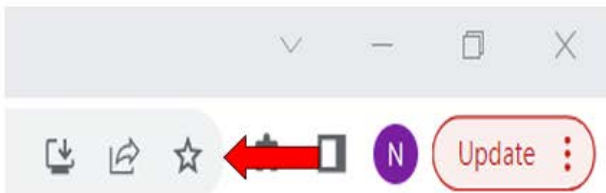

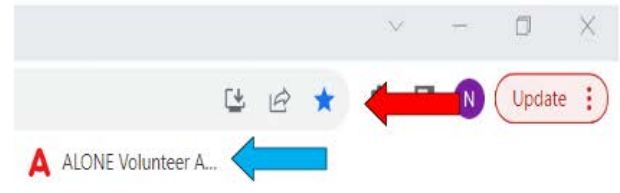
